GCCAC Transit Driver Places First in MD Statewide Roadeo



Garrett Transit Service Head Start and transit driver **Matt Paugh** earned his third first-place win in the 2022 Transportation Association of Maryland Statewide Roadeo, **Garrett County Community Action Committee Inc.** announced.

Paugh has competed in the Statewide Roadeo nine times. Having won in 2017 and 2019, he broke his personal best score this year with an overall score of 734. With 13 years of professional driving experience with GTS, Paugh won the title by

demonstrating driving skills and knowledge of transportation and transit safety information. Transit drivers are scored on obstacle course maneuvering, successful passenger stops, pretrip inspections and wheelchair securement.

"I love driving," Paugh said. "I followed in my grandfather's footsteps to Garrett Transit Service and got the opportunity to work with the kids in Garrett County Community Action's Head Start program. Working for GTS has changed me greatly; I'm happy and grateful to continue progressing as a driver to serve Garrett County families and individuals better."

Office of Head Start Expands **Eligibility to SNAP** Recipients

On April 21, 2022, the Office of Head Start released an Information Memorandum (IM) expanding Head Start eligibility to families that are eligible for or receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits. The expansion is effective immediately.

New LIHEAP Heat Stress Dashboard

On Friday, April 22nd, OCS released the <u>Mitigating Heat Stress</u> <u>for Vulnerable Populations DCL</u> to Low Income Home Energy

Assistance Program (LIHEAP) grant recipients. The DCL provides resources and tools to help mitigate the impact of heat stress on the vulnerable populations we serve, including the new <u>LIHEAP Heat Stress Geographic Information System (GIS) Dashboard</u>.

The Dashboard provides information on the progression of extreme heat over time, the health impacts of extreme heat, and visualizations on how LIHEAP alleviates extreme heat stress for vulnerable populations. The tool can be used by grant recipients and other interested parties to explore data visualizations on extreme heat days over time, extreme health related hospitalizations, the impact of energy burden on vulnerable populations, and more.
