NCAP Shares New Report:
Without Monthly Child Tax Credit,
3.7M Children Returned to Poverty in January 2022

A <u>new report from the Center for Poverty and Social Policy at Columbia University</u> found that child poverty in America jumped from 12.1% to 17% in the past month due to the lack of CTC advance payments. Among Latino and Black children, the increase was even higher (7.1 percentage points and 5.9 percentage points, respectively). Data also demonstrates that <u>families spent these funds on essentials</u>, including food, clothing, school supplies, and utility payments.

Multilingual Videos to Promote the Importance of COVID-19 Vaccination

<u>The Protecting Immigrant Families Coalition</u> has developed a suite of videos, telling one person's story to assure immigrant families that getting the COVID-19 vaccine will have no consequences on immigration status or applications.

It's built around research-tested messages and informed by the experiences of organizations that work directly with immigrant Latino, AAPI, and Black families.

The videos are available in 30-second, 60-second and 2-minute versions and in a variety of languages spoken by Community Action customers nationwide, including Arabic, Haitian Creole, English, French, Korean, Mandarin Chinese, Spanish, Tagalog, and Vietnamese.


